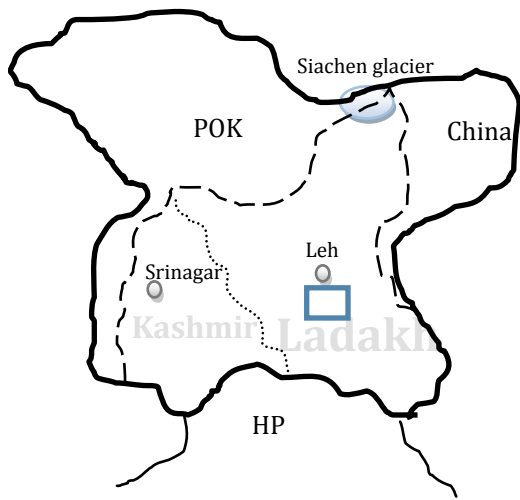
A WINTER IN LADAKH

Leh in winter

The days are short, but the Sun is warm, and the locals sit on rooftops or in the Leh market and just chat in between cups of salty tea. We take a leaf out of their book and ease ourselves into that rhythm. The plentiful coffee shops, walking paths, eating joints help.



Around Leh

ITINERARY: 6 DAY TRIP, 4 DAYS OFF WORK (1 WEEKEND)

10 MAR	Fly into Leh. Book any convenient flight. Pickup from airport will be arranged.	This is the trickiest part of the entire trip, but something we have no choice about. The only way to reach Ladakh in winter is by a flight. On reaching, we will take all precautions necessary to acclimatize.
11-14 MAR	In and around Leh.	We will pick one region around Leh every day, only a short drive away, and explore places there. Monasteries, schools, Indus river, etc. The second half of the day will be spent in Leh, just chilling, or doing things that you would like to. Evenings will be inside our spacious and comfortable hotel.
15 MAR	Fly back from Leh.	Just as we came in, we fly back. Book any flight which is convenient.

COST FOR THE TRIP:

Stay and food	On twin sharing basis at the Grand Dragon hotel. Breakfast is included. Other meals and snacks not included.
Local exploration	Will explore Leh and nearby places on foot and vehicles as needed.
Transportation	Local SUVs for all our road journeys. Also airport pickup and drop.

The cost of the trip =
Rs 40000/- per person
including all taxes.

WHAT TO GET ALONG?

It will be cold. Temperature ranges from 10 degrees in the day to -5 degrees in night. But with the right clothing and preparation, we will be just fine. We follow the layering concept for clothes and add right protection for head and feet. A detailed checklist will be provided on signing up. Note that Leh market will be partially open and you can buy woollens and jackets, etc., from there also. More importantly, the hotel is centrally heated and indoors will be comfortable.
